Saint Etienne International Design Biennial 2008 will be taking place over two weeks from Saturday 15th to Sunday 30th November 2008 (including two weekends), which means that the public will be able to take advantage of an additional weekend compared with past events.

The Cité du Design team, under the leadership of Elsa Francès, is organising the event for a second time, and Saint Etienne International Design Biennial will be celebrating its 10th anniversary in November 2008.
